Charities Compliance Record 2022

Approval to enter into a Lease/Licence

➤ Variation of lease for Box Hedge Commercial for Fota Business Park and Licence Agreement for 12 months from 1/07/2023. There is no fee being charged.

The approval of a rent review for the head office premises at 21 Lavitt's Quay Cork between Hilltrent LTD (O Callaghan Properties Ltd) and Cork ETB. The rent review date is 26th November 2020 and is detailed in the attached document. Original rent agreed 25th November 2015 was €11.70 per sq foot for the ground floor is increasing to €20 per sq foot equating to a rental cost €86,000 per annum.

First & Second Floor l€22.49 per sq foot as agreed on 25th November 2005 increasing to €23.50 per sq foot equating to a rental cost €247,361 per annum.

Car park Charges of €10,000 decreasing from €12,000.

Lease is in place until 09/03/2031. DoE approval has been sought.

The approval of the licence between Cork ETB and Glen Rovers Hurling Club for the use of the grounds at Ballincollie Road, Ballyvolane, Cork, T23 E6PK for Saint Aidans Community College Cork. The proposed licence is for 15 years from the 04/09/2023 and ending on 03/09/2038. There is no cost associated with this licence agreement. DoE approval has been sought.
