### **Notice for the Election of Staff to the Board of Cork ETB**

Cork Education & Training Board will hold an election, under the provisions of Section 3 and Section 30 of the Education and Training Boards Act, 2013, for the purpose of electing Staff Representatives (one Male and one Female) to be members of the Board. The electors will be the staff whose names are entered on the Electoral Roll.

### **Electoral Roll**

Cork ETB has compiled an electoral roll of eligible staff member electors. It is available for inspection in Cork ETBs Head Office, 21 Lavitt's Quay, Cork, T12 HYT9.

### **Nomination of Candidates**

The Nomination Papers are available from the Returning Officer. The nomination papers must be sent back to the Returning Officer, Cork ETB, 21 Lavitt's Quay, no later than 13.00pm, Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> April, 2024.

Please note that:

- (1) Each candidate must be nominated by means of a separate nomination paper and declaration of consent.
- (2) Each candidate's nomination paper must be signed by not less than 5 eligible electors whose names are entered on the electoral roll for the constituency for which the candidate is nominated. An elector may not sign more than one nomination paper.
- (3) Completed nomination forms and declarations of consent must be delivered by the nominee in person or by post so as to reach the Returning Officer, at 21 Lavitt's Quay, Cork, between the date of publication of this notice and 1pm on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> April 2024.
- (4) A nominee shall not be entitled to have his or her name entered on a ballot paper:
  - (a) for more than one ETB
  - (b) unless he or she has been duly nominated and the nomination has been ruled as being valid by the Returning Officer.
  - (c) if employed in certain staff grades, the duties of which are wholly or mainly of an administrative, Executive, or clerical nature, as designated by the Minister for Education.
- (5) The Returning Officer will rule on the validity of nomination papers between the hours of 2pm and 5pm on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> April 2024.
- (6) A candidate may withdraw up to 12 noon on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> April 2024.

If more than one candidate will be validly nominated, for the relevant constituency, a postal vote process will take place.
